This is an application to extend the time granted for curing the defects.

- 2. The facts of the case are that the Appellant filed the Memo of Appeal on 13.03.2019 and the Office after scrutiny of the Memo of Appeal on the same day, intimated the defects to the Appellant on 14.03.2019 and returned the Memo of Appeal to the Appellant on the same day. The Appellant re-filed the Memo of Appeal on 28.03.2019. It is stated in the Interlocutory Application (IA) that the defects could not be cured on 25.03.2019 as the instructions had to come from Australia and one of the defects being that the power of attorney was filed in photocopy and the original was required to be filed.
