This is an application to extend the time granted for curing the defects.

- 2. The facts of the case are that the Appellant filed the Memo of Appeal on 13.03.2019 and the Office after scrutiny of the Memo of Appeal on 14.03.2019, intimated the defects to the Appellant on the same day and returned the Memo of Appeal to the Appellant on 15.03.2019. The Appellant re-filed the Memo of Appeal on 29.03.2019. It is stated in the Interlocutory Application (IA) that there were only two defects and when on 25th March, 2019, the Memo of Appeal was presented before the Registry, the defect no.2 was removed. However, with respect to defect No.1, the Registry did not accept the submission. Thereafter, counsel was not available. Hence, there is delay of 08 days in re-filing the Memo of Appeal, so, the same may be condoned.
- 3. Heard the learned Counsel appearing for the Appellant, perused the averments made in the IA as well as Office report.

- 4. Considering the submissions made on behalf of the Appellant and for the reasons mentioned in the IA, which are sufficient, the delay in re-filing the Memo of Appeal is hereby condoned.
