This is an application to extend the time granted for curing the defects.

2. The facts of the case are that the Appellant filed the Memo of Appeal on 10.02.2020 and the Office after scrutiny of the Memo of Appeal on 11.02.2020, intimated the defects to the Appellant on the same day and returned the Memo of Appeal to the Appellant on 14.02.2020.
