ORDER

(1.11.2017)

Heard the counsel of both the sides. Learned counsel for the applicants/ appellants submits that in this matter the impugned order was passed on 5th May, 2017. The counsel for the respondent submits that the same was uploaded on the website of NCLT around 19th May, 2017 and the moment they come to know, the application for certified copy was filed on 19th May, 2017 as can be seen from the certified copy itself, and the copy was prepared and issued on 23rd June, 2017 and if time is calculated from 23rd June, 2016, 45 days will be over on 7th August, 2017. It is stated that on 7th August, 2017 a holiday was declared on account of Raksha Bandhan vide office order No. F.No.10/76/2017-Estt./NCLAT dated 1st August, 2017 and the present appeal was filed on 8th August, 2017. According to him there was no delay in filing the Appeal.

Learned counsel for the respondent submits this time has to be calculated

from 5^{th} May, 2017. The counsel says that as the Respondent no. 7 was not

there, he cannot say if the order was pronounced in the open court or passed in

the chambers.

Even if the time has to be calculated from 5th May, 2017, it would be within

the period of 45 days which this tribunal can condone.

If the matter is considered, looking to the same, it is in interest of justice

to condone the delay. We condone the delay. The appeal will be taken up for

consideration. The application stands disposed off.
