This is an application to extend the time granted for curing the defects.

The facts of the case are that the Appellants filed the Memo of Appeal on 15.04.2019 and the Office after scrutiny of the Memo of Appeal on 16.04.2019, intimated the defects and returned the Memo of Appeal to the Appellants on the same day. The Appellants re-filed the Memo of Appeal on 01.05.2019.
